- Make my first commitment to my team and my coaches – that is, if I decide to play another sport and there are conflicts between that sport and soccer for practices and games, I will always choose soccer;
- Talk to my coach if I have a problem or a question;
- Practice my skills at home;
- Work hard in school; and
- Respect my parents, whose efforts make my participation on the Team possible.

I affirm that I/we will:

- Encourage my child to give his/her best effort on the field, develop good sportsmanship, to work on his/her skills at home, and to show respect for his/her teammates, coaches, game officials, and opposing teams, by demonstrating the same;
- Ensure that my child arrives on time to practices and to games;
- Communicate with the Team Manager and/ or Coach to let them know if my child will be late to practice, or cannot attend a practice or a game;
- Let the coach do his job, not be a side-line coach during practices or games, and respect the coach's decisions;
- Conduct myself properly at all times when players of Basin United Soccer are involved, with the understanding that the Basin United Soccer Club organization and coaches will not tolerate embarrassment and indiscretion at games and tournaments;
- Communicate openly with the Coach, Team Manager, and Club over any issues or concerns;
- Volunteer time to support team and club commitments;
- Fulfill the financial obligation in a timely manner according to the payment schedule or otherwise arranged with the Club. I understand a five day grace period will be given for payment; failure to pay in this timeframe will result in my child being prohibited from future games and limited to one practice per week until payment is made. I will share in additional team expenses as they may arise for scrimmages, uniforms, travel costs for tournaments and/or incidental items. I also understand refunds will not be issued if my child leaves the Basin United team during the season.
